Varanasi is a cultural centre, with traditional music and dance performances often a part of Holi celebrations. Folk artists, musicians and dancers showcase their talents, adding to the festive spirit of the occasion. Holi is also a time to enjoy special sweets and festive foods. Gujhiya, a sweet dumpling filled with khoya (milk solids) and dry fruits, is a popular Holi dish. People exchange these sweets with friends and family as a symbol of goodwill.



### **JAIPUR (RAJASTHAN)**

The Pink City Jaipur organizes a grand Holi festival at the City Palace. The festivities include traditional music, dance and throwing of colors in the backdrop of the majestic palace. Traditional Rajasthani folk dances like Ghoomar and Kalbeliya are performed, and musicians play lively tunes on traditional instruments. #### ANANDPUR SAHIB (PUNJAB)
