The CMS Open Payments Program is a public database that tracks payments from pharmaceutical and medical device companies to healthcare providers. The program was established by the Affordable Care Act to increase transparency in healthcare payments.



Overview of CMS Open Payments

Transparency

The program aims to increase transparency in healthcare payments by making data on payments between pharmaceutical and medical device companies and healthcare providers publicly available.

Public Database

Data Collection

Pharmaceutical and medical device companies are required to report all payments made to healthcare providers.

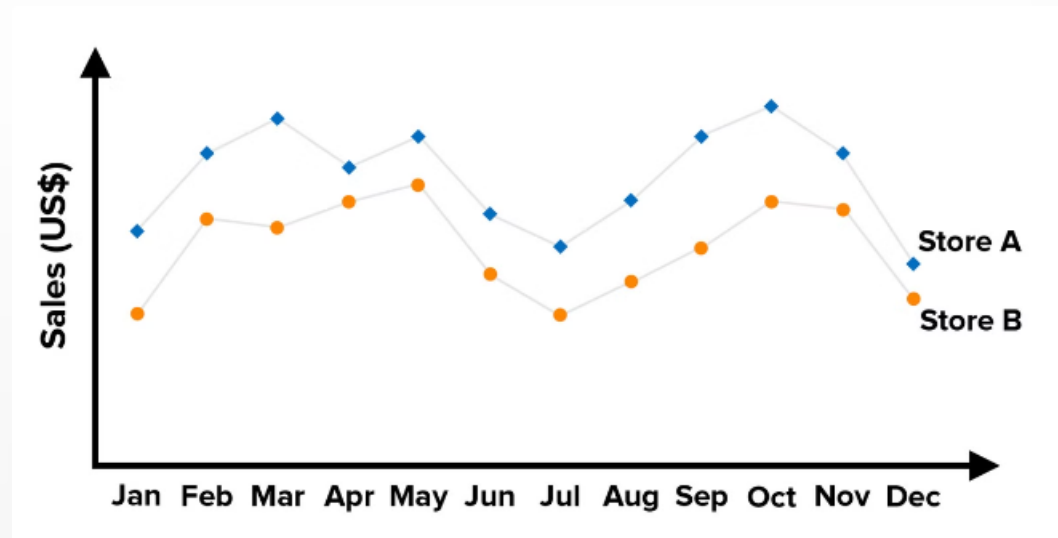
Data Validation

CMS verifies the accuracy and completeness of the reported data.

Public Reporting

The validated data is made publicly available through the CMS Open Payments website.





Transparency in Healthcare Payments

Public Disclosure

All payments made to healthcare providers are disclosed in the CMS Open Payments database.

Detailed Information

The database includes information on the type of payment, the amount of the payment, and the date of the payment.

Patient Access

Patients can use the CMS Open Payments website to search for information about their healthcare providers' financial relationships.

Data Submission

Pharmaceutical and medical device companies submit data to CMS through an online portal.

2

Data Validation

CMS validates the submitted data for accuracy and completeness.

3

Data Correction

Companies are required to correct any errors in the submitted data.

Public Website

The CMS Open Payments website provides a user-friendly interface for accessing the data.



Downloadable Data

The data is available for download in various formats, such as CSV and XML.



Application Programming Interface

The data can be accessed through an API, allowing developers to integrate the data into their applications.



Data Visualization

The website offers tools for visualizing the data, making it easier to understand and interpret.

Compliance and Enforcement



1 Compliance Requirements

Pharmaceutical and medical device companies are required to comply with the reporting requirements of the Open Payments Program.
