CMS Open Payments is a transparency program by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services that requires the disclosure of financial relationships between healthcare providers and pharmaceutical companies.

### OIG CHECKS

OIG checks refer to the process of screening individuals and entities against the Office of Inspector General's (OIG) List of Excluded Individuals and Entities (LEIE).



### SANCTION CHECKS



Sanction checks are screenings conducted to ensure that individuals or entities are not on any government or regulatory body's sanction lists.

### OIG SCREENING

Conducting OIG Screening is a critical step in safeguarding your healthcare organization from engaging with excluded individuals or entities.

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# The Importance of CMS Open Payments, Sanction Checks, and OIG Check

## CMS Open Payments

Transparency in physician payments promotes ethical behavior and accountability, ensuring patients receive high-quality care without undue influence from financial incentives.

## Sanction Checks

Verifying that individuals and entities are not subject to sanctions protects the healthcare system from potential risks and ensures that only qualified providers are involved in patient care.

## OIG Check

This check identifies individuals and entities excluded from participation in federal healthcare programs, preventing fraud, waste, and abuse within the system.





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## Risks of Non-Compliance

- 1 Financial Penalties**

- 4 Exclusion from Programs**
