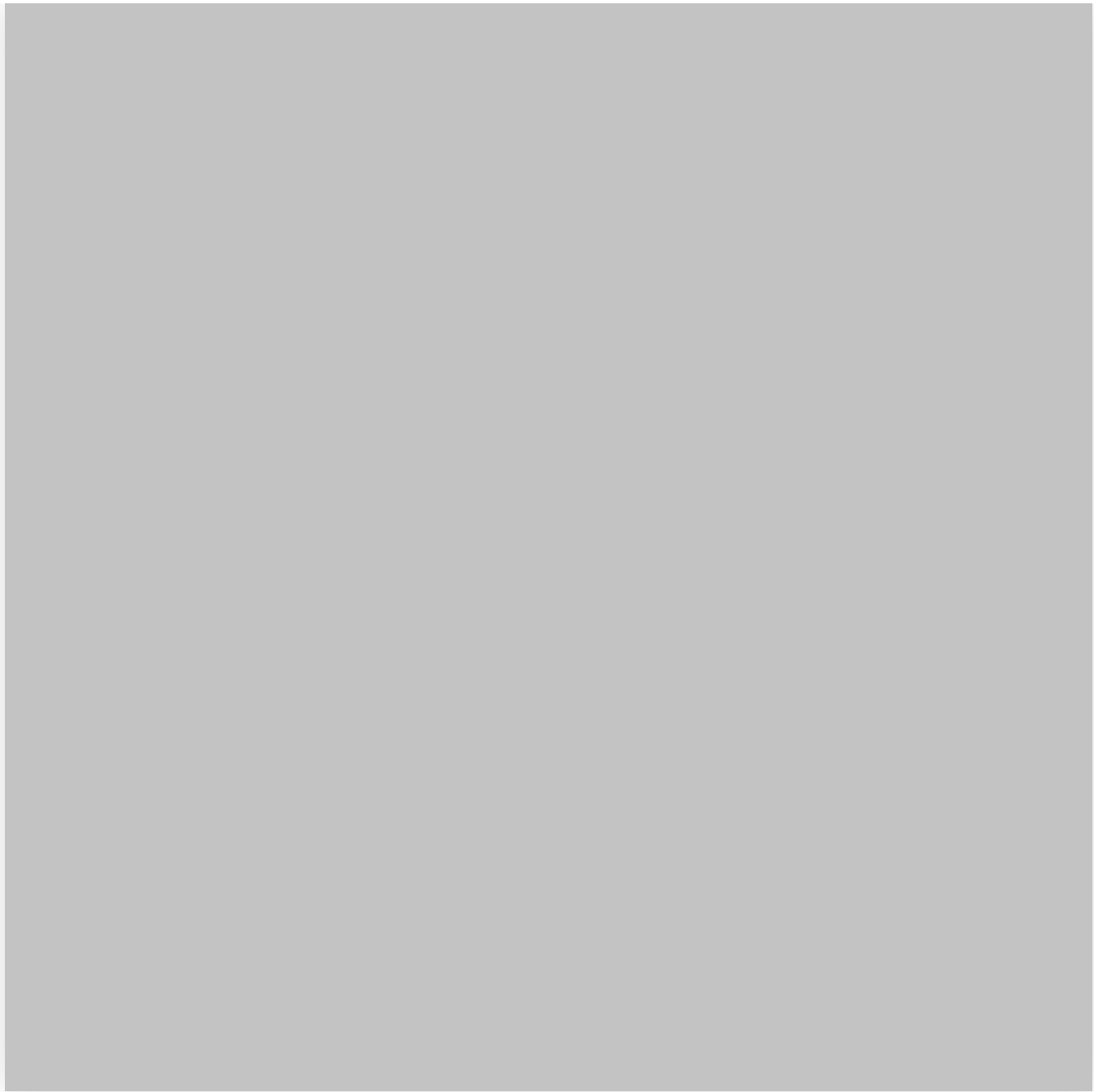

2. Hanuman Garhi – A Must-Visit Hanuman Temple

Ayodhya holds the Hanuman Garhi temple as one of its most important religious structures which worships Lord Hanuman. Climbing to the temple site located on a high elevation provides visitors with stunning views over the urban area. The local legend tells how Lord Hanuman resided in this location to safeguard Ayodhya.

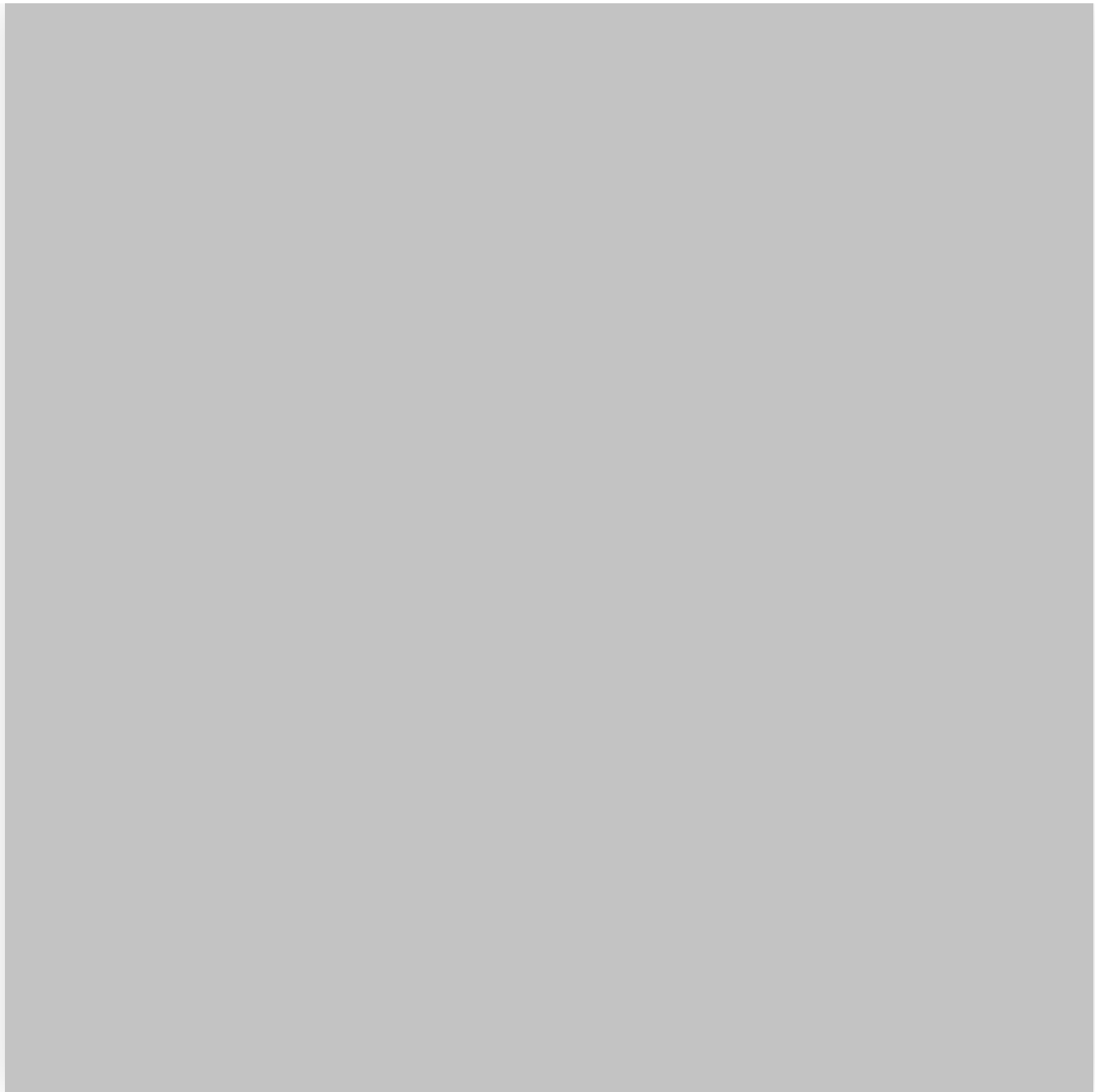

Things to Do at Hanuman Garhi:

- The temple stands at a location accessible by steps leading to 76 step-ups where visitors can seek blessings from Lord Hanuman.
- Watch the majestic evening aarti performance while experiencing a spiritual transcendence only at the temple.
- The temple spot gives visitors sweeping views of Ayodhya as it stands in an elevated position.

3. Kanak Bhawan – The Golden Palace of Sita and Rama

The temple dedicated to Lord Rama and Goddess Sita stands as a beautiful place of worship known as Kanak Bhawan. Queen Kaushalya provided Sita with the temple after she married Lord Rama. Visitors will find the temple attractive because of its decorative gold statues along with detailed artwork.

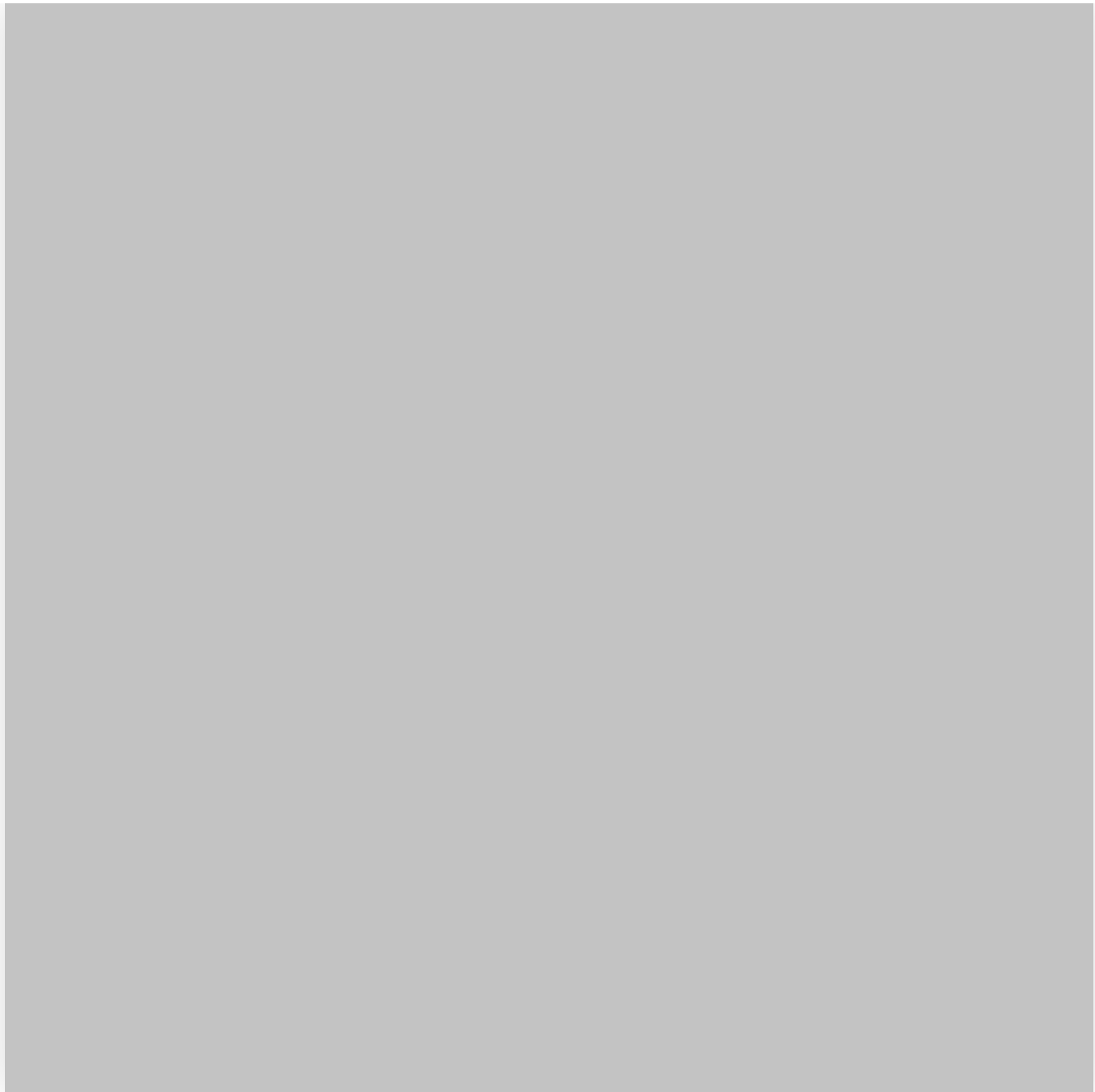

4. Saryu River and Ghats – A Spiritual Retreat

Meditating people use the ghats located along the river including Ram Ki Paidi to perform religious ceremonies and witness evening aartis as well as take sacred swims. People can find relaxation and meditation easily because of the peaceful riverbank ambiance.

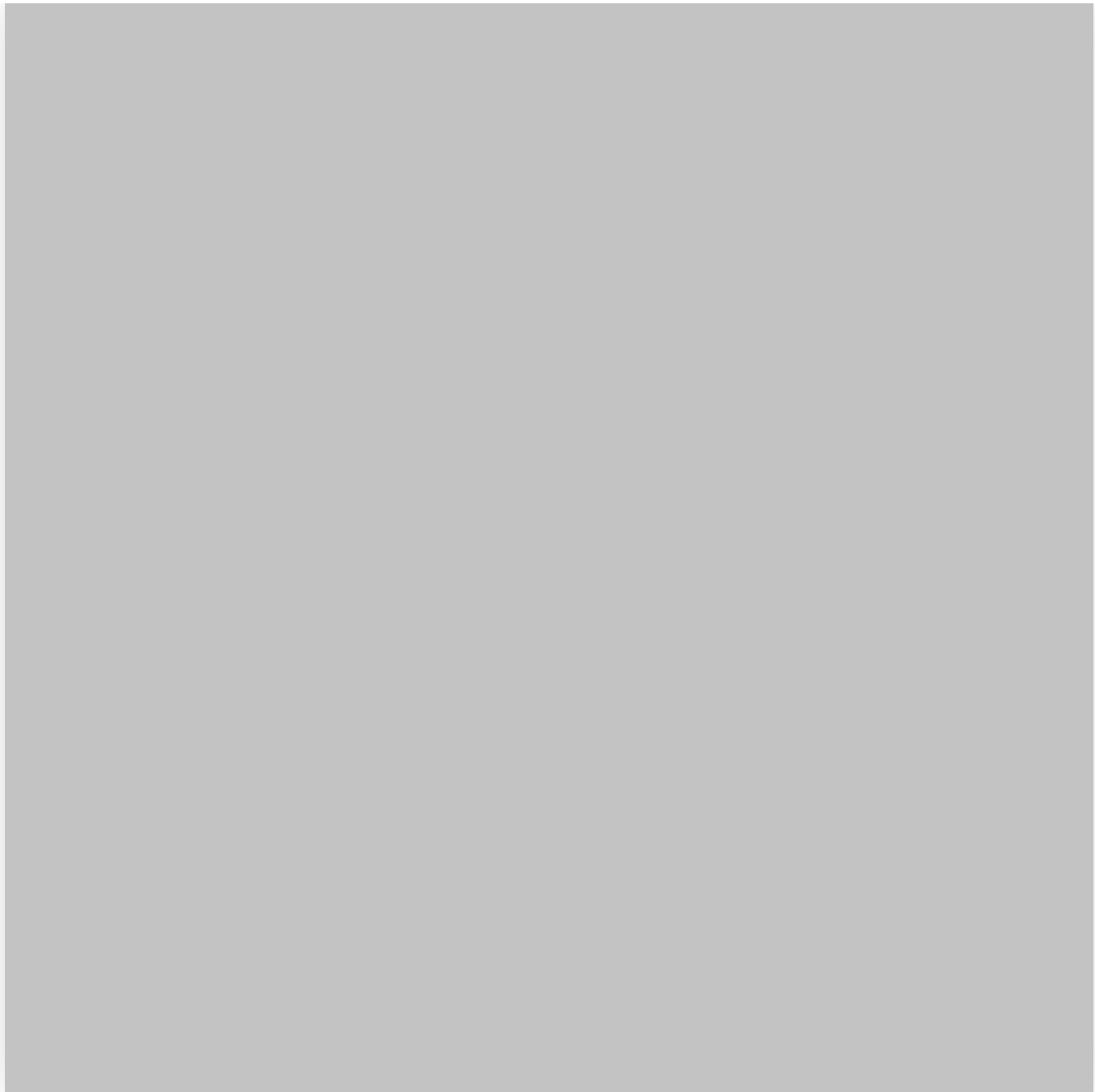

5. Treta Ke Thakur – The Ancient Rama Temple

People widely recognize the significant historical temple Treta Ke Thakur as the site where Lord Rama conducted his Ashwamedha Yajna. Several ancient deity idols of Lord Rama alongside Sita and Lakshmana Hanuman and others are found in this temple after being worked from a single black stone.

Chana Masala: A popular vegetarian dish.

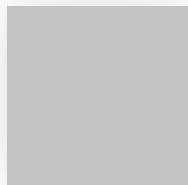
2. What are the religious daily express times for visiting Ram Janmabhoomi?

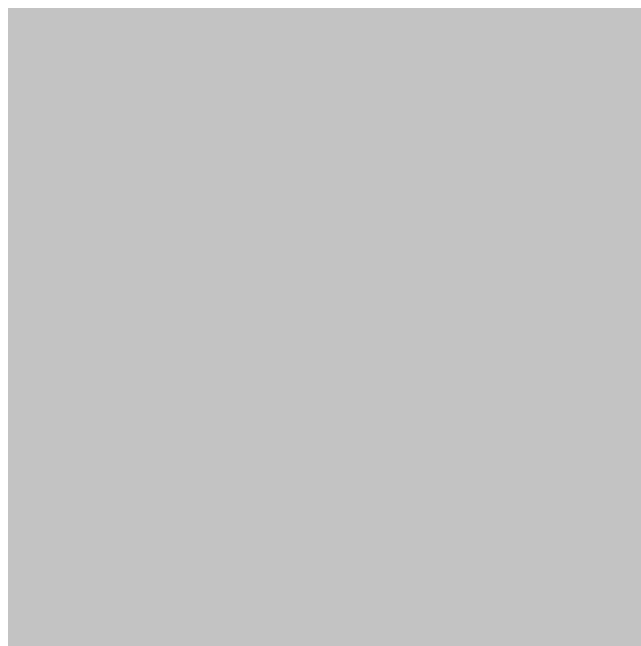
